Title IX Resource Guide for Responsible Employees (Faculty and Staff)

Henry Ford College is committed to fostering a safe and caring environment that prohibits all forms of sex discrimination, harassment, misconduct and/or violence. Those who become aware of such prohibited conduct must promptly report it to a Title IX Coordinator so a timely, thorough, fair investigation can be conducted, the matter can be appropriately resolved, and appropriate steps can be taken to prevent recurrences. Creating a safe environment is the responsibility of all members of the College community.

When a student/employee approaches you to inform you of a sex discrimination, harassment, misconduct or violence situation, inform them of the following **before** they reveal information, they may wish to keep confidential:

- All faculty and staff are obligated by law to report information to the College's Title IX Coordinators including the name of the student /employee involved, the alleged perpetrator and relevant facts including dates, times and locations of the incident(s).
- They may share the information confidentially with counseling, advocacy and other support services such as the BIT and CARE teams.
- They have the right to file a complaint with the Title IX Coordinator(s) and to report the information to the Dearborn Police Department.
- They have the option to request confidentiallyty and the College's Title IX Coordinator(s) will consider and make every effort to respect the request keeping in mind the College's responsibility to provide a safe and nondiscriminatory environment.
- It is against College policy to retaliate against an individual who reports any type of discrimination, harassment or misconduct including Sexual Misconduct.
